- Information by application



MOTOR CARRIER

- Business that provides transportation
- Where operating
 - Intrastate
 - One state
 - Does not cross state lines
 - Must meet the registration and proof of financial responsibility imposed by the state (only state) they operate in
 - Individual state information can be found in ISO's Motor Carrier Digest

- 2. The reimbursement clause applies for Form F.
- B. Filing (See Note 1.)
 - 1. For intrastate authority granted and interstate exempt operations, use Uniform Motor Carrier Bodily Injury And Property Damage Liability Certificate Of Insurance Form E.

For motor carriers holding dual FMCSA/intrastate authorities, use Form E and Forms BMC 91 or BMC 91X.

- For taxicabs, livery vehicles, funeral home vehicles, medical transport vehicles and tow trucks, a certificate of insurance must be submitted to the Secretary of State.
- C. Cancellation (See Note 1.)
 - For property carriers and buses, 30 days' notice is required. Use Uniform Notice Of Cancellation Of Motor Carrier Insurance Policies Form K.
 - 2. For passenger carriers, 10 days' notice is required to the Secretary of State.
 - 3. For tow trucks, 30 days' notice is required to the Secretary of State.
- D. Expiration Notice
 - 1. For property carriers and buses, expiration notice is not required.
 - 2. For taxicabs, expiration notice shall expire automatically on December 31 of each year, or on such other date as the Commission may prescribe.

B. Filing

For intrastate motor carriers, use Uniform Motor Carrier Bodily Injury And Property Damage Liability Certificate Of Insurance Form E.

C. Cancellation

30 days' notice is required. Use Uniform Notice Of Cancellation Of Motor Carrier Insurance Policies Form K. Form must be approved by the department and the Texas Department of Insurance.

D. Expiration Notice

Expiration notice is not required.

B. Filing

1. Property Carriers

Use Certificate of Insurance DMV MCP 65. (See Section 8.)

2. Passenger Carriers

Use Motor Carrier Automobile Bodily Injury Liability And Property Damage Liability Certificate Of Insurance Form PL 914 (Original 6/88). (See Note 2.)

See Note 3. for further requirements.

C. Cancellation

For property and passenger carriers, 30 days' notice is required except in the advent of cessation of operation as a highway carrier. For property carriers, use Notice of Cancellation DMV MCP 66. (See Section 8.) Passenger Carriers use PL 916 (Original 6/88) Notice of Cancellation of Bodily Injury Liability and Property Damage Liability Insurance. (See Note 5.)

Passenger carriers use Motor Carrier Automobile Bodily Injury Liability And Property Damage Liability Passenger Carriers Notice Of Reinstatement PL 917 (Original 6/88).

D. Expiration Notice

Notice is not required.

FOR-HIRE MOTOR CARRIER CROSSES STATE LINES

- Federal regulated interstate motor carrier
 - Now only deal with federal government to register as an interstate motor carrier – This step will allow the motor carrier to haul all cargo and to operate in and through all states



FOR-HIRE MOTOR CARRIER CROSSES STATE LINES CONT.

- State requirements
 - UCR Safety LUE Transportation Funding Bill of 2005
 - INTRASTATE REGISTRATION FOR AN INTERSTATE OPERATION IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE UCR AGREEMENT
 - (a) Once the registrant has complied with the filing requirements and payment of the UCR fees, the State may not require any additional payment of motor vehicle fees or issue any credentials for operation within or through the State for an annual intrastate renewal.



FOR-HIRE MOTOR CARRIER CROSSES STATE LINES CONT.

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

The filing of evidence of financial responsibility of the motor carrier or motor private carrier operating in interstate commerce shall be established by the Secretary. Any State or any political subdivision of a State may not require the filing with the State of information pertaining to the financial responsibility of the motor carrier or motor private carrier for the transportation of property or passengers in interstate commerce.



FOR-HIRE MOTOR CARRIER CROSSES STATE LINES CONT.

Motor carrier who might have to meet state requirements

- 1. Operating only within that state (intrastate) Must meet state registration and FR requirements
- 2. Interstate Might have to meet state FR in state they are <u>domiciled</u> or if intrastate operations in that state in addition to interstate No requirement to meet FR or registration in states that they are domiciled in under the UCR requirements



FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY ADMINISTRATION (FMCSA)

- FMCSA oversees interstate motor carriers
 - Registration
 - Meet financial responsibility requirements (forhire, some private)



REGISTRATION

Obtain a DOT# - MCSA-1

 The US DOT# serves as a unique identifier when collecting and monitoring a company's safety information acquired during audits, compliance reviews, crash investigations and inspections



REGISTRATION CONT.

- Anyone using a vehicle for commercial purposes in interstate commerce that has a GVW of 10,001 pounds or larger (6 wheels – small wheels) or combo
- Does this include private as well as for-hire?
 - Yes!
 - If the definition is met, must have a DOT# and meet the payment responsibilities under UCR
 - Could have to meet financial responsibility
 - For-hire/Hauling hazmat
 - Must obtain a DOT#
 - Pay a fee (UCR)

- Required for obtaining:

 - Some intrastate

SAFER HELP

Physical Address

Refers to the physical location of the company's principal office. The following data elements are included:

- STREET. Identifies the street address where the company's principal place of business is physically located.
- CITY. Identifies the city where the company's principal place of business is located.
- . STATE. Identifies the State where the principal place of business is located. Two-letter postal abbreviation for the state.
- ZIPCODE, (EXPANDED ZIPCODE). Zip code which corresponds to the street address of the company's principal place of business (Any valid U.S. or Canadian zipcode or CANADA; MEXICO or CENTRA). Expanded zipcode refers to the last four digits of the zipcode. Example 37815-0310. If the expanded zipcode is known, the field will contain the dash (-). Some Canadian and Mexican addresses contain the word CANADA or MEXICO as part of the zipcode and Central American countries' zipcodes contain CENTRA. The first 5 characters will be stored in the ZIPCODE field and the last character will be stored in the EXPANDED ZIPCODE field.

Phone

The company telephone number at the principal place of business.

Mailing Address

The address at which a company receives mail.



USDOT#

This is the number assigned by MCMIS to a census record. It is sometimes referred to as the USDOT number. Each company should have only one active census number. The census number has no internal coded structure. Numbers are issued sequentially as carriers/shippers/registrants are added to the system.

State Carrier ID

Company I.D. number assigned by the state, often used in lieu of the USDOT#, for intrastate carriers/shippers/registrants.

MC/MX/FF Number(s)

Carrier number issued by the FMCSA granting authority for interstate operations. Prior to January 1, 1996, the MC number was issued by the Interstate Commerce Commission. Freight Forwarder docket numbers and MX numbers will also be listed in this field.

DUNS Number

This is the corporate registration number given by Dun & Bradstreet.

Entity Type

Refers to the type of operation in which the motor carrier is engaged. It identifies the entity as a carrier, hazardous materials shipper, both a carrier and a shipper, or



Carrier Operations

Identifies the carrier as being engaged in interstate, intrastate hazardous material, or intrastate non-hazardous material transport activities.

Shipper Operations

Identifies the shipper as being engaged in interstate or intrastate hazardous material shipping activities.

Operation Classification

Identifies the type of motor carrier. MCMIS recognizes the following classifications for motor carrier type (NOTE: A carrier can have more than one type of classification):

- Authorized-For-Hire. A commercial motor carrier whose primary business activity is the transportation of property/passengers by motor vehicle for compensation.
- Exempt-For-Hire. A for-hire motor carrier transporting commodities or conducting operations not subject to economic regulation by the FMCSA.
- . Private (property). A motor carrier whose highway transportation activities are incidental to, and in furtherance of, its primary business activity.
- Private/Passenger Business. A private motor carrier engaged in the interstate transportation of passengers which is provided in the furtherance of a
 commercial enterprise and is not available to the public at large.
- Private/Passenger Non-Business. A private motor carrier involved in the interstate transportation of passengers that does not otherwise meet the definition
 of a private motor carrier of passengers (business) (e.g., church buses).
- Migrant. A motor carrier who transports in interstate or foreign commerce at any one time, three or more migrant workers to or from their employment (refers
 to "contract carrier by motor vehicle").
- · U.S. Mail. A motor carrier which transports U.S. Mail.
- · Federal Govt. Transportation of property or passengers by a U.S. Federal Government agency.
- · State Govt. Transportation of property or passengers by a U.S. State Government agency.
- Local Govt. Transportation of property or passengers by a local municipality.
- Indian Tribe. Transportation of property or passengers by an Indian tribal government.
- . Other Classification. A motor carrier which does not fall into one of the classifications above (Description is in "Other" field).



Power Units

Identifies the number of Trucks, Tractors, Hazardous Material Tank Trucks, Motor Coaches, School Buses, Mini-Bus/Vans and Limousines owned, term leased of trip leased by the motor carrier.

Drivers

Total number of drivers employed by the carrier/shipper.

MCS-150 Form Date

Date from the MCS-150 Registration Form.

MCS-150 Form Mileage

Mileage from the MCS-150 Registration Form.

Cargo Carried

Identifies the type of cargo transported by the carrier/shipper.



Carrier Safety Rating

This is a measure of the carrier's compliance with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSR). Motor carriers rated before 1986 were assigned safety ratings based on previous procedures used to determine the carriers compliance with the FMCSR such as a Safety Management Audit, or a Re-investigation conducted on the carriers operation. Beginning in October 1986, motor carriers were assigned a safety rating based on a Safety Review or a Compliance Review. A Safety Review is an overview of a motor carrier's knowledge of the FMCSR. This covers all major areas of the Safety Regulations. Much of the rating is based on an interview with management. The main purpose is to educate a carrier about the FMCSR. A Compliance Review is a statistical sampling or audit of required records to determine a motor carrier's compliance with the FMCSR. An in-depth review of the motor carrier's records is made to check different categories of drivers, vehicles and trips. This review may be limited to specific problems and may include a detailed investigation of a problem area. The compliance status determination is based on FMCSR violations discovered during the review.

Any of the following codes may be found in this field:

- Satisfactory; Records indicate no evidence of substantial non-compliance with safety requirements.
- Conditional; Records indicate that the carrier was out of compliance with one or more safety requirements.
- Unsatisfactory; Records indicate evidence of substantial noncompliance with safety requirements.

EFFECTIVE DATE. The date the Safety/Compliance Review was input into MCMIS thus generating a safety rating.



Operating Status

- OUT-OF-SERVICE: Carrier is under any type of out-of-service order and is not authorized to operate.
- Inactive USDOT Number: Inactive per 49 CFR 390.19(b)(4); biennial update of MCS-150 data not completed.
- AUTHORIZED FOR { Passenger, Property, HHG }: This will list the specific operating authorities the carrier (or broker) is allowed to operate.
- NOT AUTHORIZED: Carrier does not have any operating authority and is not authorized to operate.
- ACTIVE: Carrier is authorized to operate.

Out of Service Date

Indicates the date the company was ordered Out of Service. If there are multiple Out of Service orders, it will be the earliest date.



APPLYING FOR INSURANCE ON BEHALF OF A MOTOR CARRIER IS UNIQUE

- Public information
 - The motor carrier applies for a DOT#
 - New application (MCSA-1) Online
 - Includes information about the business
 - The information must be updated when a change in operations and must be updated every two years
 - -Update information MCS150
 - » Every two years based on DOT#'s last two digits second from end year odd or even last month



APPLYING FOR INSURANCE ON BEHALF OF A MOTOR CARRIER IS UNIQUE CONT.

- The agent obtains information from the insured
 - Does the information provided by insured match what the insured has told the government?
 - If operation has changed, update MCS150
 - Explain differences with application
 - The first thing the underwriter looks at is the public information
 - CAB Carrier Software
 - Agents, do you have the same information as the underwriters?



THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

- The federal government requires that a motor carrier that uses a CMV in interstate commerce obtain a DOT#
 - Users of a vehicle for commercial purposes in interstate commerce that has a GVW of 10,001 pounds or larger
 - Not an 18-wheeler but a unit with six tires (small tires)
 - For-hire and private
 - Yes
 - What is interstate
 - When items being transported cross state lines
 - Either the unit is providing transportation or the unit is used to provide local movement
 - If the definition is met, must have a DOT# and meet responsibilities under UCR



THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT CONT.

- Some states have adopted federal rules and regulations
 - Intrastate only
 - States requiring federal DOT#'s
 - Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, New Jersey, New York, Nebraska, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Puerto Rico, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Washington, West Virginia, Wisconsin and Wyoming
 - If DOT# information in Safer



THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT CONT.

- Requirements
 - -Obtain a DOT#
 - Who they are and what their operations are –
 Information on federal website
 - –Pay a fee UCR




THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT CONT.

- Could have to meet financial responsibility requirements if forhire or private hazardous – 91X/MCS90
 - OP1 MC number
 - But
- The FR only protects the public Not the insured (motor carrier)
 - Only becomes involved when no coverage

- Licensing & Insurance

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
